Pesticide Training and Testing

The law associated with this area of our program is the Kansas Pesticide Law. We certify private and commercial applicators to use pesticides. To qualify for certification, a commercial pesticide applicator must show adequate knowledge of the type of pesticide application that he or she intends to perform.

Qualified Applicator License

To obtain an agricultural basic pesticide applicator license, the candidate must pass one written, closed book examination. The test is called the Core Exam and covers general pesticide information. The passing score is 80%. Once the exam is passed, the candidate is certified for three years and is eligible for a license.
